Does the theme-based approach in Oxford Advantage Little Champs and Classes 1-2

have a positive impact in improving students' subject knowledge?



Background

Oxford Advantage is an integrated learning solution, providing schools with a comprehensive suite of educational materials and services —including curriculum content (both print and digital), a digital delivery platform, comprehensive reports, theme plans, weekly plans, daily activity plans, tasks for formative assessment (classes 1-2), lesson plans (classes 1-2), teacher training and school marketing services.

The curriculum of Oxford Advantage Little Champs and Classes 1-2 (Foundational Stage) provides engaging and enriching experiences to build on the prior knowledge of the learners, who then create their own knowledge by immersing themselves in the themes that have been interwoven across subjects. Research question

An impact study was undertaken to understand:



To what extent do teachers perceive that the use of the theme-based approach in **Oxford Advantage Little Champs and Classes 1-2** has had a positive impact in improving students' subject knowledge at the foundational stage?







An impact study* was commissioned to find out the extent to which teachers perceived that the use of **Oxford Advantage Little Champs and Classes 1-2** improved their students' subject knowledge at the foundational stage. OUP India carried out one-to-one in depth interviews with **27 teachers** from **11 schools**. The interviews comprised both open-ended and closed questions.

*An impact study is research that investigates a particular change a product or service has on the group of people it is intended to help or benefit. Oxford Impact is OUP's approach to evaluating the impact that our educational products and services have on teaching and learning. At the heart of Oxford Impact is the **Oxford Impact Framework:** a rigorous process for evaluating impact, developed with the National Foundation for Research (NFER) and supported by the Oxford University Department of Education.



Key findings

Majority of participants agreed that Oxford Advantage Little Champs and Classes 1-2 had a positive impact on students' overall subject knowledge.

Key findings

All participants agreed that the thematic organization of concepts across subjects in Oxford Advantage Little Champs and Classes 1-2 have a positive impact on students' knowledge of the language and vocabulary associated with the subject they are studying.



There are certain sections like 'Let's go', which help students to connect their knowledge, 'words to know' help in understanding the difficult words, and phonic sounds help them in reading. They have learnt about hard and soft sounds and their usage is evident in their pronunciation and language.
